The Chapter 102 AE team joined hands with Civil Air Patrol to sponsor a special STEMtoSpace engagement program for Montgomery Public Schools (MPS) Bear Exploration Center for Math, Science, and Technology School's 5th grade students.

The program, coordinated nationwide by the Air Force K12 STEM Office, allowed Guardians from the U.S. Space Force to introduce 4th-6th grade students to the new U.S. Space Force (USSAF) in celebration of the December 20th second birthday of the USSF.

Lt. Col. Joan Thompson, Commander of the 13th Delta Operations Squadron, who spoke at the USSF Space Delta 13, Space Training and Readiness Command welcome at Maxwell AFB in September, was invited to speak at the school. Lt. Col Thompson inspired the students to engage in STEM subjects and do well in school so a future space career could be in their horizons.
